Please see below regarding the policies and procedures for free Downey student admission.

GENERAL POLICIES & PROCEDURES

Each student and their family will be permitted to enter the space center at no charge upon the first visit. At this time, the parent and/or guardian will be asked to fill out the necessary registration form and provide the necessary documents to confirm Downey residency and/or Downey school attendance. Once the registration form is filled out and the documents are provided, students will be provided with a free admission card. The admission card must be presented each time student wishes to enter the Space Center at no charge. Please note that family attendance is free *only* for the first visit. Family members will be required to pay each visit thereafter.

Any of the following documents will be accepted to confirm residency and/or school attendance.

- Parent/Guardian Driver’s License
- Parent/Guardian California Identification card
- Student Report Card with School Address
- Parent/Guardian Utility Bill
- Student Identification (School or California)
- Teacher or Principal Notice on school letterhead
- Reference Letter on school letterhead

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

Students will be responsible for their own admission card. If a card is misplaced, a \$5.00 replacement fee will be charged at the time of admission.

Any lost or stolen cards should be turned in to the Space Center.
